BROWN BAG TUESDAYS

The City of Huntington City Services is working hard to serve its residents. Our Grapple Truck picks up brown bags on Tuesdays and brush and limbs by the end of the week. We appreciate your cooperation so we can be as effective and as efficient as possible. Our guidelines for the Brown Bag Program are to help reduce landfill waste by composting items that will decompose.

FAQ ABOUT BROWN BAG TUESDAYS

To schedule a Tuesday pick up, you must call City Services any time before 7 a.m. Tuesday. Requests made after 7 a.m. Tuesday will be picked up the following Tuesday.

Brown bags may only contain items that will decompose, such as grass clippings or sticks. Items for recycle will not be picked up.

Plastic bags or boxes are not acceptable.

Brown bags are to be placed by the street in the grass and not in an alley or on a sidewalk.

Do not place brown bags next to anything else, such as your trash can, car, fire hydrant, etc.

Brush and limbs that do not fit into brown bags can also be set out in piles for pick up by the end of the week.

Please help us by putting only household trash in your trash can and call us for Tuesday pick up of decomposable items.
