NEIGHBORHOOD GARAGE SALE



This year's garage sale is on May 14. You are responsible for obtaining your \$3 garage sale permit from the City Clerk Treasurer. The Board will put a notice in

the TAB. The Salvation Army will pick up any unsold, unwanted items between 3 PM and 4 PM on Sat., May 14. If you would like the truck to come to your house, please send an email to carlislecrossinghuntington@gmail.com or send a Facebook message to the Carlisle Crossing page. The drivers will stop at houses looking for items at the end of the driveway. They will also have a receipt book if you'd like to get a receipt from them.

PET RESTRAINT

You are responsible for your pet(s) even if they are within an electric fence as these are not a guaranteed method of restraint. If you have a problem with neighborhood dogs or pets while walking/biking on public spaces, contact Animal Control. The Huntington County Animal Control Officer is dispatched through the Huntington County Sheriff's Office. Please call the non-emergency dispatch number at: (260) 356-8316.

According to city ordinances, all animals must be properly restrained. An animal shall be considered properly restrained if kept: indoors, confined within a safe and adequate structure, or tethered. Also, the owner or agent of an animal shall immediately remove the animal's excrement from public or private property, (excepting a handicapped person working with a guide dog.)

NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY
