

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CARLISLE CROSSING COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.

The incorporator or incorporators, desiring to form a corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Not-For-Profit Corporation Act of 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), execute the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation is: CARLISLE CROSSING COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation are formed are:

- 1. To provide for maintenance, preservation and iHumination of the residence lots, other parcels, streets, and recreational areas within various parcels of real estate located in Huntington County, Indiana, which are or will be platted into sections to be known as Carlisle Crossing and its various sections, and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents and occupants within said platted areas.
- 2. To exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in the Protective Restrictions, Covenants, Limitations and Easements for Carlisle Crossing and its various sections, in Huntington County, Indiana, recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Huntington County, Indiana, as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided in said Protective Restrictions, Covenants and Limitations being incorporated herein as set forth at length.
- 3. To fix, levy, correct, and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of said Protective Restrictions, Covenants and Limitations; to pay all expenses in connection thereto and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the corporation including taxes or governmental or other charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association.

- 4. To acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise all real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association.
- 5. To borrow money, and with the assent of three-fourths (3/4) of each class of members, mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred.
- 6. To dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the common areas to any public agency, authority or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed to by the Board of Directors.
- 7. To have and exercise any and all powers, rights, and privileges for which a corporation may be organized under the Indiana Not-For-Profit Corporation act as amended or as will in the future be amended.
- 8. To maintain any common impoundment basin and recreational areas which may be utilized by draining surface waters from the various platted parcels and otherwise occupies areas in Huntington County, Indiana, and otherwise to require proportionate contributions by way of assessment or otherwise from persons or entities served by such areas or basins.

ARTICLE III

PERIOD OF EXISTENCE

The period during which the Corporation shall continue is: perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

RESIDENT AGENT AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP

One membership shall be created for each lot or living unit planned in all sections of Carlisle Crossing. Membership shall be comprised of owners of lots in all sections of Carlisle Crossing.

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee interest in any lot in Carlisle Crossing and its various sections, in Huntington County, Indiana, which is subject by Protective Restrictions, Covenants and Limitations of record to assessment by the Association including contract sellers, shall be a member of the Association. The foregoing is not intended to include the performance of an obligation. Membership shall be appurtenant and may not be separate from ownership of any said lot which is subject to assessment by the Association.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

The initial Board of Directors is composed of three (3) members. If the exact number of Directors is not stated, the minimum number shall be three and the maximum number shall be fifteen, provided, however, that the exact number of directors shall be prescribed from time to time in the By-Laws of the Corporation; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL THE MINIMUM NUMBER BE LESS THAN THREE (3).
